A Letter from the President



We hope everyone is doing well, staying healthy, and looking forward to great days ahead of us. In the last Diamond Newsletter, we sent out information on USPS promotional discounts. I am trying to educate all of our clients on the real value behind these promotions. What looks like a large expenditure goes a long way in getting your direct mail envelopes opened and increasing your response. The big picture is the theme of this letter.

If you are planning to mail, especially if you mail a large number of envelopes monthly, I would highly recommend taking advantage of using some enhancements on your outer envelope to increase response. The cost of using a trail edge design may cost a die and some additional set up, but over the cost of many mailings or one large mailing, this cost will look minimal. Overall embossing is another enhancement that will get you tactile discounts from the USPS. The cost may look significant, but over a one-year period of mailing 5MM or 10MM pieces, this cost would be relatively minimal

in your overall budget. With the USPS promotional savings, it would actually net a gain because our price is per thousand and the discount is per piece. The big picture is if you spend \$5,000.00 to \$15,000.00 additional for your envelopes, you will have a better product that stands out, and you will save \$10,000.00 or more depending on the size of your mailing. You can find even more savings if you mail again, because now you have the embossing pattern or trail edge units paid for.

With what has gone on in our country and the world over the past year, we all need to think about the big picture. This is a small period of time in our lives, but our entire future is the big picture. Hopefully we can look back and say "Wow, made it through that! I can do anything!"
